Application deadline (postmark or FAX) is October 1, 2010. \$800.00 of the applicable registration fee must accompany the application. Winners will be selected by random drawing by November 1, 2010. Winners need not be present to win. Previous recipients of Cranial Academy Foundation scholarships are ineligible.
